## 10 YEAR RESIDENTIAL INSTALLATION LABOR WARRANTY

Intersource, Inc., a Minnesota corporation, warrants the workmanship of floor covering installation labor for a period of 10 years from the date of completion of installation. This warranty is valid only for original owner-occupied residential installation labor of first quality floor covering, cushion, underlayment and other necessary materials purchased from and installed by Intersource, Inc. The original owner is required to maintain the floor covering according to the manufacturer specific maintenance guidelines. Should installation service be required attributable to the original installation of flooring during the warranty period, contact Intersource, Inc. to arrange for service at no charge to the original owner. Types of service provided at no charge include reworking of seams which gap, unravel or fray; restretching of carpet which wrinkles, re-adhering detached tile/plank, and replacement or repair of transition materials which become detached under normal use.

This warranty will be invalidated if concern is due to improper maintenance or cleaning, misuse, abuse, excessive moisture, inadequate moisture, alteration of original installation work, vandalism, mold and mildew, flooding, natural disaster, or other events and actions outside the control or influence of Intersource, Inc. Installation failure or deficiencies caused by environmental or structural conditions are not covered by this warranty.

The following additional conditions are not considered installation-related defects or poor workmanship and are not covered by this warranty:

Carpet: visible seams normally required for installation.

Hardwood flooring: gapping between boards and trim, scratching, and moisture-related concerns

Other flooring comprised of natural material: moisture-related concerns

Vinyl/Rubber flooring: visible seams normally required for installation.

All floor covering material quality and performance warranties are subject exclusively to the terms and conditions of the manufacturer warranty.

This warranty is not transferrable.

This limited warranty gives original owner specific legal rights and original owner may also have other rights that may vary from state to state.
